# 2019-2024 Strategic Plan

Right now, around the world and in Canada, we are seeing governments step up their attempts to rollback hard-won victories on sexual and reproductive rights, limit access to critical health care services like abortion, and create a world that is unsafe for LGBTQI2S+ people, women, Indigenous peoples, and other marginalized folks. But we have an opportunity to change that — and ensure that Canada plays an important role on the world stage in advancing human rights.

From our very first days following the merger of Action Canada for Population and Development, Canadians for Choice (formerly CARAL), and the Canadian Federation for Sexual Health (formerly Planned Parenthood Federation of Canada), to our recent victories on securing historic funding for sexual and reproductive rights globally, our organization has made enormous strides. In the past five years, we have grown from a small handful of staff to a robust, cross-country, and international team of over 20 with more diverse and sustainable programming and partnerships.

As we enter our next phase as an organization, we know it is time to take a transformative approach to our work here in Canada and around the globe. With the support of our partners, funders, community members, volunteers, staff, and board, we can strengthen the movement for universal access to abortion and contraceptive access, accurate reproductive health information, stigma-free services, comprehensive sexuality education, and sexual rights.

Guided by our mission for sexual and reproductive health and rights for all and our strategic goals, we can have made even more progress by 2024.

- 4. We address and challenge oppression, including racism, misogyny, homophobia, transphobia, and classism.
- 5. We aspire to work with communities and movements that are marginalized or have been historically disadvantaged.
- 6. Our organization and our work are rooted in feminism and human rights.
- 7. We are a sex-positive organization and we believe that sexuality should be a positive element in life.
- 8. We believe in helping people acquire the tools and knowledge necessary to advocate for sexual and reproductive health and rights for themselves and their communities.
- 9. We are justice-seeking movement-builders that participate in political, health, education, and human rights spaces, both at the grassroots and policy level.
- 10. We aspire to be a good partner to other organizations, individuals, and activists.
- 11. We value information and knowledge-sharing rooted in evidence and science.

# Increased access to rights-based sexual and reproductive health information, education, and services

- Strengthening our 24/7 Access Line usage with better staffing capacity
- Monitoring and improving online service directory usage with increased access options for people, especially young people
- Building a national campaign for comprehensive sexuality education for all
- Dismantling barriers to medical and surgical abortion access by working with health care providers and governments to build capacity and secure coverage
- Continuing to grow the reach of our national STBBI testing campaign Onceayear.ca
- Improving the accuracy of health services information available on our site and through partnerships with service providers across the country



# Strengthened laws and policies for the realization of sexual and reproductive rights

- Leverage international human rights accountability mechanisms to hold governments accountable to their sexual and reproductive rights obligations
- Holding the line on and defending against rollbacks of policies and laws around abortion, comprehensive sexuality education, and contraception at the federal, provincial, territorial level
- Advancing our calls on cost coverage for sexual and reproductive health drugs and commodities and a federal sexual health survey
- Securing increased financial and political support for the neglected areas of SRHR, like contraception, abortion, sex-ed, and advocacy for SRHR in Canada's development assistance and foreign policy
- Engaging in strategic litigation to protect sexual and reproductive rights



## Amplified movements and coalitions for sexual and reproductive health and rights

- Pushing for advancements on SRHR in global policy processes including the United Nations international human rights system
- Increasing and analyzing the reach of our website and social media channels for users and followers
- Increasing action taken on SRHR issues by individuals and organizations, through digital activities, social media, and other mobilization campaigns
- Strengthening coalition work with partners, like the Future
  Planning Initiative, in critical areas
- Ensuring that we meet our values around diversity, equity, and inclusion by serving and working with more diverse communities
- Growing and maintaining our strategic partnerships
- Strengthening of the work of the Sexual Rights Initiative
