The webpage development component of the RFP will provide Action Canada with a professionally designed web page to house our Rights from the Start project content that prioritizes user-experience and seamlessly integrates with CiviCRM and the existing Action Canada website (<a href="https://actioncanadashr.org">https://actioncanadashr.org</a>).

# Background

Action Canada is an organization that works in Canada and around the world to promote health, well-being, and rights related to sexuality and reproduction. Building on the 50-year legacy of the organizations that formed Action Canada, we provide direct support, referrals, and information to the people who need it most, partner with groups and organizations on a range of campaigns using a collaborative, movement-building approach, and work with decision-makers to advance progressive policies on access to abortion, stigma-free healthcare, gender equality, LGBTQ rights, and inclusive sex-ed. The Rights from the Start project uses feminist and human rights-based approaches to promote and advance comprehensive sexuality education and sexual and reproductive health and rights. We work collaboratively with allies from civil society movements, community leaders, educators, researchers, decision-makers, health care workers, women, men, and young people in Bolivia, Ecuador, Guyana, Peru, and Canada. We are working to ensure the delivery, promotion, and advancement of sexual and reproductive health and rights for



women, men, and young people - especially adolescent girls. We want all people everywhere to be empowered to make free and informed decisions that are right for them.

Action Canada is currently undergoing an audience mapping of its existing audiences and possibilities for growth. The successful vendor will support Action Canada's public engagement with the updating and upgrading of our CiviCRM database to effectively document existing audiences and incorporate new audiences in ways that recognize their diverse interests and engagements with the organization and the project.

#### **WEBPAGE**

Action Canada is currently leading a project entitled Rights from the Start. The project is a partnership with organizations in Latin America and the Caribbean. While the primary audience is the Canadian public (English and French speakers), secondary audiences include English and Spanish speakers from the Latin American and Caribbean region.

# **Technical Requirements**

## CiviCRM Database

## Content Management System

The site is developed using Drupal 8 (with a scheduled upgrade planned for Drupal 9), using Paragraphs. An improved authoring experience with Layout Paragraphs and inline help is important to our content authors and editors to create engaging pages with diverse content.



## Web Host

Our current production site hosting is at Blackfly Solutions (<a href="https://blackflysolutions.ca/">https://blackflysolutions.ca/</a>). There are two sites: <a href="https://actioncanadashr.org">https://actioncanadashr.org</a> for content and https://secure.actioncanadashr.org for CiviCRM data and webforms. The successful firm will have access to the Gitlab repositories to create working branches for both sites, and coordinate with Blackfly to submit pull requests to testing/production environments.

## **Browser Support**

Rather than list all current operating systems and browser devices in use by our current audiences, you should test your work against modern browsers to make sure it provides equivalent functionalities on all of them. This is about making our content accessible to all users. Ensure you don't make any operating specific design assumptions (e.g. different OS's deal with file paths and names differently).

#### **User Accounts**

CiviCRM will require additional roles for content authors, event planners, and analysis of outcomes.

# **Content Migration**

Part of our CiviCRM database project is to migrate existing audiences and lists into CiviCRM to ensure all of our audiences are in the same database for easy audience mapping, targeting, and growth.

# Trilingual (French/English/Spanish) website pages

Our current website includes a toggle to switch between languages. The new website development work adds Spanish content and ensures that language toggle options are only available where a translation exists.

# Agile Method

The process will be cooperative and include a regular feedback loop between Action Canada and the vendor.

# **Budget**

\$65,000 CAD (including tax) broken down as follows:

- \$25,000 CAD (web development)
- \$40,000 CAD (CiviCRM)



# **Project Timeline**

We expect both the landing page and CiviCRM work to be completed by fall 2021.

## Criteria for Selection

- Technical expertise: Demonstrated experience in CiviCRM and Drupal 8/9.
- **Communication and autonomy:** Ability to manage project independently in addition to the ability to teamwork; pursue and meet established timelines without monitoring/prompting.
- Partner: Ability to act as a partner in the project build by involving our team but also taking the lead when needed.
- Flexibility: Ability to adapt when needed to unforeseen project changes.
- **Vision:** Will provide ideas for project beyond what is presented initially based on expertise in the field and the unique needs of our organization and project.
- **User interface design:** Ability to create user-centered design, engaging the user from start to end and making their experience as seamless as possible.

## Your proposal must include:

- Examples of similarly complex projects (to assess technical capability) in both CiviCRM and Drupal 8/9
- Client references and whether email or phone is better (to assess credibility)
- Project timeline with major tasks and milestones (to assess process)
- Project budget by line item (to assess process)
- Plan for mobile / responsive design (to assess familiarity with current trends)
- List of team members responsible for what with brief descriptions (including any subcontractors). All subcontractors must be approved by Action Canada.
